
About Us

Nasza Księgarnia publishes traditional classic as well as modern works for younger children, teenagers, young adults, and has successfully launched its adult publishing list.




Therapeutic fairy tales are exceptional stories, constructed and written in such a way that children find in them an element of themselves, their feelings, emotions and problems. Healing tales give support, a sense of security and often help release guilt. They also include many suggestions as to how a child

can deal with a given problem. They have one more advantage: anyone can become a fairy tale writer. In our collection we have stories written by cinema, television and theatre celebrities: Artur Barciś, Olga Borys, Ryszard Cebula, Katarzyna Dowbor, Cezary Harasimowicz, Paulina Holtz, Krzysztof Ibisz, Rafał Królikowski, Grażyna Wolszczak, in addition to those by professional writers like Małgorzata Strękowska-Zaremba, Dorota Suwalska, Agnieszka Tyszka, and Janusz Wiśniewski. They are accompanied by advice and comments by Katarzyna Klimowicz and Dagna Ślepowrońska. We hope that they will be helpful to parents and children, and that they will inspire conversation, games and above all reflection on the most pressing problems.

The book is mature literature, a good read, and from a social perspective, a valuable proposition directed at children and their guardians. It wisely and subtly suggests how to talk about a given story, without ruining the reading experience or invading the child's privacy.


The Adventures of Filemon the Cat


ately call the police! It will be a true horror, before kids discover where babies come from...

Considering that time can deform the events which have been imprinted on our memory, while the author's objectivity, despite his intentions, readily succumbs to the whispers of the imagination, I decided it would be appropriate to assign fictional names to my characters, not excluding the narrator.
